



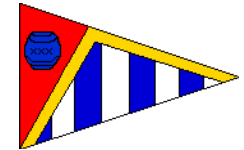

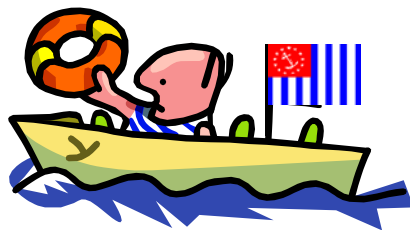

U.S. Coast Guard Safety Initiative Puts "You" in Command

"You're in Command" is the U.S. Coast Guard's new public safe boating outreach initiative, which encourages all recreational boaters to take responsibility for their actions on the water. As a boat owner or operator, you are responsible for your safety and the safety of your passengers. That's why we say: "You're in Command. Boat Safely!"

The Facts

*The Coast Guard's most recent boating-related accident statistics show:

- 750 fatalities — 4,062 injuries — \$39 million in property damage.
- Eighty-five percent of drowning victims were not wearing life jackets.
- Alcohol was involved in nearly 40 percent of all boating fatalities.
- About 80 percent of all boating fatalities occurred on boats where the operator had not completed a boating safety education course.
- The most reported types of accidents are collisions with other vessels. However, capsizing and falls overboard are the most reported types of fatal accidents and account for over half of all boating fatalities.
- Overall, operator inattention, carelessness/reckless operation, operator inexperience, and excessive speed are the leading contributing factors of all reported accidents.

It's clear that a great majority of these could easily have been prevented!

You're in Command Key Messages or What You Can Do To Boat Safer

1. Get a Vessel Safety Check
2. Take a Boating Safety Course
3. Wear Your Life Jacket
4. Don't boat under the influence

Also, visit the You're in Command Resource Center if you're a boating-safety advocate who'd like to help spread the word about boating safety.

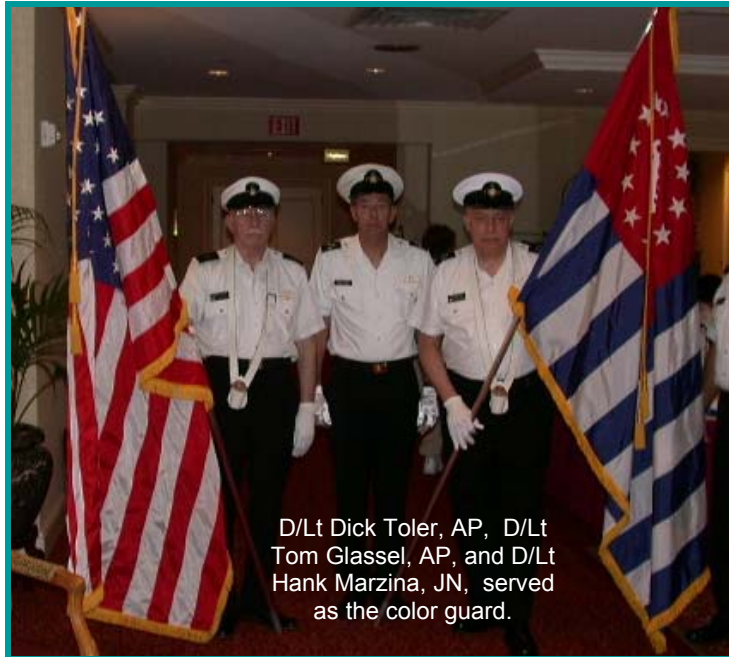

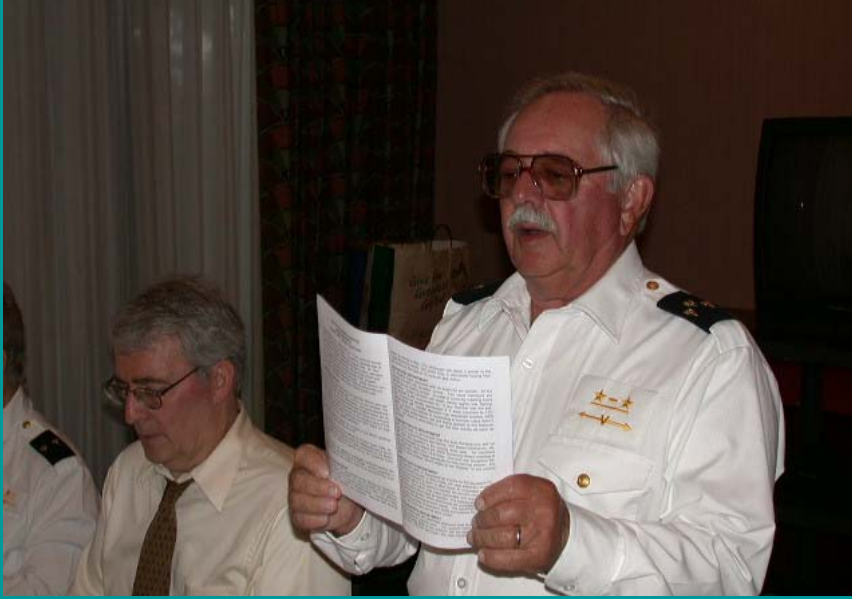
The next meeting will be at Willow Tree Grove in South Park on 9 June. The meeting adjourned at 2040.

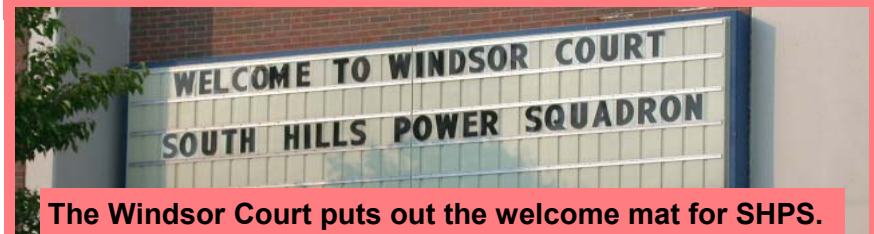
